

- Road to Wall Street was spearheaded by alumni on Wall Street who were passionate about recruiting Rutgers students into front-office positions
 - Cohort 8: 100% Full-Time Placement; Cohort 9: 100% Internship Placement
 - Cohort 9: 40.5% Investment Banking, 19% Sales & Trading, 7% Equity Research, 9.5% Investment Management, and 5% Buy-Side
- Goal: help you land the best summer internships possible, which often turn to full-time roles
- In order to ensure well-rounded growth:
 - Summer Preparatory Work & Mock Interviews in Early Fall Semester
 - Fall Financial "Modeling & Market Analytics" 3 Credit Course
 - Peer Mentor, Junior & Senior Alumni Mentor, 1-on-1 time with the Director & Assistant Directors

Front Office Placement Statistics





- Front Office internship placement has increased every year
- The total number of Investment Banking internships has increased from 9 in the Class of 2020 to 17 in the Class of 2022
- In the Class of 2023, 85% of accepted offers were for Front Office internships
 - Compared to 1 2% overall
 acceptance rate, across banks
 (Financial Times)

 Merriam Webster: the system that includes the circulation of money, the granting of credit, the making of investments, and the provision of banking facilities


What are different types of Finance Firms?

Investment Banking

Functions Include:

- Raising Capital
- Strategic Advisory

Industry & Product Groups:

- Technology, Healthcare, Financial Institutions
- M&A, Leveraged Finance

Sales and Trading

• Sales:

- Serve as a hub of information
- Pitch ideas to Clients on new investments or products

• Trading:

- Manage a portfolio
- Make Markets, provide liquidity, take trades

Equity Research

- Produce reports and issue a recommendation (buy, hold, or sell) on stocks
- Clients include:
 - Asset managers, portfolio managers, hedge fund managers
- Typically cover a specific industry

Asset Management

- Investment Side
- "Manage" a portfolio or assets
- Institutional or private clients
- Help generate investment ideas
- Work with portfolio manager to execute strategies
