

## Petition for Masters of Accountancy in Financial Accounting Advanced Standing

A student may receive two (2) credits for each three (3) credits of undergraduate upper-division course work completed with a "B" or better (at least a 3.0) at an AACSB accredited institution.

If you have taken courses which are comparable to the content of the Rutgers Business School-New Brunswick undergraduate upper-division core courses listed below and have received a "B" or better, you may petition to receive up to a maximum of six (6) credits.

No advanced standing/transfer credit can be awarded for any courses taken more than five years before the time of initial enrollment in the MAccy in Financial Accounting program.

- 1. Complete this form only for *Advanced Standing*.
- 2. Include *description*, *course(s) numbers and name of institution*.
- 3. Submit by the end of your second semester.
- 4. Must have an official transcript on file with a graduation date.
- 5. Must apply for a minimum of 4 credits.
