# OFF-CAMPUS HOUSING

Please note that you should not move into Cedar Lane Apartments, Treetop Apartments, or any other apartment in Highland Park - unless you are buying a car. The university stopped bus service to that area a few years ago. The road to our building from there is narrow with no sidewalk or room for bicycles. There are plenty of other apartments with bus service and sidewalks.

# AIRPORT SHUTTLE SERVICE

To better serve our students, Rutgers University has partnered with a local ground transportation service to transport you from your arrival airport (Newark, JFK, LaGuardia or Philadelphia) to our New Brunswick Campus. You don't need to have cash or a credit card. The cost of the service will be charged to your term bill.

Although we provide transportation from all four of these airports we strongly encourage you to choose Newark Int'l (EWR) as your arrival airport being that it is much closer to campus and in turn more affordable.

Rutgers is offering town cars which will accommodate two students, two large pieces of luggage and two carry-ons. In addition, vans with group pricing rates will also be available if multiple students arrive at the same airport around the same time. Typically, vans can accommodate 7-8 people with luggage.

All students must provide at least 72 hour notification to the Housing & Residence Life Office to ensure curbside<sup>[1]</sup> pick-up on the designated day and time of arrival. Once your application is submitted you will be contacted by the Housing & Residence Life Office regarding further details on your travel arrangements. If you do not receive word within 48 hours, please contact our office at oncampus@echo.rutgers.edu

To apply please re-visit the Housing Application page through the Housing Application Site and submit an Airport Shuttle Application.

Please keep in mind that the rates listed below EXCLUDE additional parking fees, tolls, and wait-time / off-hour surcharges. On the day of your arrival an exact fare will be determined and charged to your student account. If multiple students arrive at the same time, the total cost of the car service will be shared.

• Wait-Time Fee: International flights are given a 60 minutes' grace period. After 60 minutes' town cars will charge \$14.44/hour and vans \$17.07/hour.

• Off-Hour Surcharges: A \$15.00 surcharge is applied to all arrivals between 11PM-5AM.

# IMMUNIZATIONS

Health and Immunization Requirements for new and transfer students are customized based upon the New Jersey health requirements for higher education and school/program needs.

# **Rutgers Immunization Portal**

All health and immunization requirements and forms are found on the Rutgers Immunization Portal (<a href="https://rutgers.medicatconnect.com">https://rutgers.medicatconnect.com</a>). This secure portal provides a central location for students to find and report the information needed to fulfill these requirements. Select Rutgers from the dropdown and then login in to the Rutgers' Portal using your netid and password. On the site you will:

- Complete the Mandatory Health Form
- Download Immunization Record Form
- Upload the immunization record once it has been completed and signed by a healthcare professional
- Enter dates of your immunizations or lab tests

All information will be verified. Unsubstantiated entries will be rejected.

# **Summary of Health and Immunization Requirements**

### 1. Mandatory Health Form:

• This online form contains information mandated by the state, needed to help categorize requirements, and some basic information about the student that will help us better care for the student on campus should the need arise.

#### 2. Immunization Record:

- Immunization requirements vary based on the needs of each school/program.
- To download the immunization packet, students go to the Rutgers Immunization Portal and click on the box for the school in which they are enrolled.
