There will be no summer session extensions, for the completion of pre-business requirements. The end of the spring semester (May) is always the firm deadline
***Students dismissed from the Rutgers Business School: Undergraduate-New Brunswick prior to meeting the requirements to declare a major are not eligible to appeal their dismissal. ***

## Class of $\mathbf{2 3}$ or 22 student with no declared major:

Did not meet requirements to declare in spring 2021 or summer 2021

- Three grades of D or F received in pre-business courses by the end of fall 2021 (NC grades will not count against you)
- Three grades of D or F received in business courses by the end of fall 2021 (NC grades will not count against you)
- Cumulative grade-point average lower than 2.5 by the end of fall 2021 (a cumulative GPA of 2.5 or higher is required to declare a Business major)
- Not completing all six pre-business courses with grades of P (pass) and/or C or higher by the end of fall 2021
- If student takes a leave of absence during the fall 2021 semester

There will be no extensions, for the completion of pre-business requirements. The end of the fall semester (December) is the firm deadline
